In order to qualify for the International Activity Patch you must complete any five activities. Activities may be from either "Part A" or "Part B".

In order to qualify for the International Activity Neckerchief you must complete 5 activities at least one of which must be from "Part B." Earning the neckerchief will also satisfy the patch requirements.

There is no time limit to satisfy the requirements of this award. Both youth and adults may earn this award.

Part A	
1.	Earn Citizenship in the World Merit Badge.
2.	Earn the World Conservation Award.
3.	Promote international Scouting at a district, council, regional, or national event.
4.	Organize a collection for the World Friendship Fund.
5.	Earn the Interpreter Strip in any language except Signing.
6.	Visit Gilwell Park in England, site of the first Wood Badge course.
7.	Host in your home for at least two days a Scout or Scouter from another country.
8.	Participate in Jamboree-on-the-Air or Jamboree on the Internet.
9.	Visit the embassy or consulate of a foreign country.
10.	Visit the United Nations building in New York.
11.	Participate in a service project in a foreign country.
12.	Attend an international scouting function held in the United States.
13.	Earn the International Scouter Award.
14.	Attend an International Representative seminar at a National BSA meeting or International Scout conference at the Philmont Training Center.
15.	Be an Interamerican Scout Foundation Order of the Condor or World Scout Foundation Baden-Powell Fellow.
Part B	
1.	Participate as a Scout or adult leader in a national contingent to a World Scout Jamboree, Pan-American Scout Jamboree, World Scout Conference or other activity held in another country.
2.	Serve on the International Service Team at a World Scout Jamboree, Pan-American Scout Jamboree, World Scout Conference or an activity held in another country.
3.	Participate as a Scout or adult leader in a local contingent of Scouts participating in an event or activity of a foreign Scout association. The activity may be an exchange program, camp experience, a tour activity, or a home hospitality function as long as it involves staying in the foreign country.
4.	Serve as a member of a camp staff in a foreign country.
